TIM ROARK, CPHI(C)

Tim Roark started his career in Northwestern Ontario after graduating from Ryerson and receiving his CPHI(C) in 1967. After two years in Ontario he moved to B.C. During the next 35 years, he gained significant experience with several local/regional health agencies as well as Health Canada both in the field and in management. Upon retirement in 2004, he established Tim Roark & Associates Environmental Health Consultants which included terms as a Consultant to the BC Food Processors Association, the Fraser Health Authority Legal Department and as author of the Emergency Response Field Manual EHOs and Health Protection Specialists.

Tim has held several positions in the Institute including President of the BC Branch CIPHI, Chair of the BC Board of Registration for PHIs as well as National President of CIPHI. He was a Founding Member of the Environmental Health Foundation of Canada in 1987 and was the Chair and subsequently Treasurer for several years. Starting in 1980 he was a member of several NSF International committees including the Council of Public Health Consultants and as the Vice Chair of their Certification Council until his recent retirement from NSF. He was a long-standing Examiner with the Board of Certification and is presently Historian for CIPHI National and the BC Branch.

During his 52 years involved in Environmental Health Tim has received a number of awards including the President's Award from the BC Chapter of CPHA, Honorary Citizen of the City of Winnipeg, the Environmental Leadership Award from NSF as well as the Alex Cross Award, co-recipient of the EHR Award and Life Membership from CIPHI.
